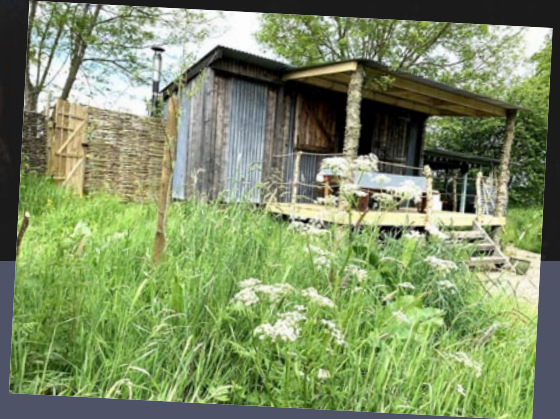
## FIND YOUR WAY AROUND

## WELCOME TO OUR SITE



On arriving at the site, please use this map to guide you to the parking areas. Once parked, the map will help you to familiarise yourself with the layout of the site and acts as a reference for all the useful information that you will need to enjoy your stay.

### Preserving the landscape

We are committed to running a business that sits as lightly on the landscape and the planet as possible. To ensure that the site is tranquil and unspoilt, the paths between the main site area and the accommodation are small tracks rather than paved or covered ones.

Similarly, there are no outdoor lights along the way, to preserve the dark skies for which the area is famed and to give as natural an experience as possible.

Both of these mean you need to remember two simple things when coming to Wild Northumbrian; wear sensible footwear and bring a torch!

Each yurt and hut are set within its own little area of the site, ensuring that you have peace and privacy from other guests.

To help transport your possessions to your accommodation, collect a wheelbarrow from the parking area. Then, using torch light if necessary, make your way to your hut or yurt and settle in.



### Toilets, showers & kitchen

The shower and toilet block have underfloor heating and are always bright and clean, ready for you to use. The kitchen hut is an ideal place to do your dishes and prepare food when you need to spread out a little. Each yurt or hut has its own shelf in a fridge so that you can keep your essentials cool, handy in warmer weather.

The site has communal kitchen shed and also a shower and toilet block in the old coach house next to the main house. Houlet, the treehouse yurt has its own composting loo and outdoor kitchen sink area. Plus a Hikki hot tub and outdoor shower, just across the path but guests are also welcome to use the shower block. Swallow Hut makes use of the shower block for toilet and shower facilities but also has a Hikki hot tub and outdoor kitchen.

### Mobile phones & internet

You are also welcome to use available sockets in the kitchen hut to charge your mobile phones etc. but please be aware that if you leave them there you do so at your own risk.

There is now a 4G mobile phone signal at the site but why not take the opportunity to switch off your devices – forget your messages, emails and social media and just... relax! The Hollybush Inn in Greenhaugh which is just a short walk or drive away has free wifi for its patrons.
